



BSO King Soopers Neighborhood Card FAQ:

The BSO receives a 5% donation from purchases made with the "BSO" cards. It is no extra cost to you. The 5% donation comes from King Soopers.

The starting value is \$5 and you use them like a credit card at King Soopers. It is best to load the card with at least \$50 at King Soopers for future purchases at the store. It can be loaded with up to \$500 and reloaded as needed.

The cards can be reloaded by any cashier (full serve and self-serve) prior to a purchase, or at the Customer Service Desk (5 min delay before a purchase can be made).

If you lose your card or it stops working, you need to get a new one from the BSO (not King Soopers). Send an email to contact@broomfieldsymphony.org. It is best to keep a balance on the card, as the card will expire if it has a zero balance for 60 days.

The back of the card tells you how to check the balance. The balance will also be printed near the top of the purchase receipt after you use the card. You could tear off the portion of the receipt with the card balance and fold it around the card to track the balance.
